

ADHHA Breeding Rules

ADHHA Registration Eligibility:

All horses with 50% or more Dutch Harness Horse blood by pedigree are eligible for ADHHA Registration.

Offspring of Sire and Dam that are both ADHHA Registered are eligible for ADHHA Registration.

Any ADHHA Recorded horse that successfully completes the ADHHA Selection Process, which consists of a Keuring held by ADHHA, is eligible for ADHHA Registration. (*see Keuring Rules*)

All horses Registered by ADHHA prior to March 15, 2011 and certain horses grandfathered into ADHHA as Dutch Harness Horses from other stud books as determined by ADHHA Board of Directors are eligible.

ADHHA Recording Eligibility:

Any mare, stallion or gelding of any pedigree, breed or stud book may be Recorded with ADHHA.

ADHHA Embryo Transfer:

One eligible ET resultant foal per mare per year shall be eligible for ADHHA Registration.

ADHHA Registration and Recording Certificates:

All ADHHA-issued Registration and Recording certificates shall remain the property of ADHHA to facilitate transfer and information updates as needed.

Approved and Licensed Stallions:

All KWPN and KWPN-NA Dutch Harness Horse and Hackney stallions Approved or Licensed prior to January 1, 2014 are grandfathered into ADHHA as ADHHA-Approved Breeding Stallions. After January 1, 2014 ADHHA-Approved Breeding Stallion status is determined by ADHHA Keuring results.

Ster, Keur and Preferent Mares:

All KWPN and KWPN-NA mares achieving a predicate of Ster, Keur or Preferent prior to January 1, 2014 shall hold the same designation when they are ADHHA Registered. After January 1, 2014 ADHHA Predicates are determined by ADHHA Keuring results.
