



## ADHHA JACKPOT FUTURITY RULES

(For foals born in 2014 and 2015)

Proceeds resulting from the sale of stallion services become the designated futurity prize money corresponding to each year's futurity program.

### REGISTRATION.

All sires and dams must be registered or recorded with ADHHA. All foals must be ADHHA registered.

### ANNUAL ELIGIBILITY and NOMINATIONS

**Sires.** Stallion services are donated by owner and sold at the Annual Jackpot Stallion Service Auction. All bids start at \$250. If a bid is not received, the stallion owner must pay a \$250 fee for the stallion to become eligible.

**Dams.** Jackpot Dams are the mares bred as a result of owner being high bidder of Stallion Jackpot Service. Jackpot Dams must be nominated by December 31 of year stallion service was purchased.

Other mares bred to eligible Jackpot Futurity Stallions are nominated by payment of \$50 fee by April 15 of foaling year.

**Foals.** Foal must be sired by an eligible stallion and out of a nominated mare. A foal enrollment fee of \$50 must be paid to the Jackpot Futurity by April 15 of the year foal is born.

**Three Year Olds.** Yearling, Two Year Old and Three Year Old \$50 nomination payments are due by April 15 of each year to retain eligibility for Harness class. Three year old must have been an eligible foal with all nomination fees paid by due dates.

**LATE FEES.** Eligibility may be reinstated by payment of all applicable nomination fees plus a late fee of \$100 for each missed deadline.

### CLASSES

### PRIZE MONEY

\$10,000 Jackpot Futurity Prize Money will be paid to owner of record and equally divided between foals resulting from their Jackpot Dams being properly nominated and their sire's service having been purchased at Stallion Service Auction which place in the Top Ten awards of the weanling class.

Remaining prize money will be paid to owner of record as follows:

60% to Weanlings placing 1st through 6th (35%, 25%, 15%, 10%, 8% and 7% respectively)

40% to Three Year Olds in Harness placing 1st through 6th(35%, 25%, 15%, 10%, 8% and 7% respectively)
